Job Summary

- The Gathering Place's Registered Dietitian is responsible for assisting in the development and implementation of programs and services addressing nutrition for individuals and families coping with the impact of cancer in their lives
- Position involves delivery of services at The Gathering Place offices, online and in the community, including establishing relationships and delivery of services in area hospitals

Key Responsibilities

- Provide direct one-to-one and group nutrition support tailored to the needs of people with cancer, including treatment-related side effects and survivorship
- Create educational materials and resources to support participants in making informed dietary choices
- Design and deliver evidence-based programming to support individuals with cancer. Create hands-on cooking classes that promote healthy eating habits and practical skills

Qualifications

- The ideal candidate for this position will hold a master's degree in nutrition/dietetics or a related field, and have licensure within the State of Ohio
- A minimum of 2 years of experience in clinical or community nutrition and strong knowledge of oncology nutrition is preferred
- Must be proficient in Microsoft Office 365

- Ability to navigate high-level interpersonal, oral and written communication skills
