This part-time role is rooted in compassion, clarity and empowerment, ensuring that each participant feels informed and supported.

The Cancer Resource Coordinator:

- Helps participants better understand their cancer diagnosis by translating clinical language and test results into clear, accessible information
- Researches and shares information on relevant clinical trials across the country
- Builds a networks of vetted financial and legal professionals to assist with practical needs such as estate planning, wills and guardianship
- Recommends helpful books, articles and educational resources for individuals diagnosed with cancer and their support systems
- Connects families with local and national organizations and non-profit agencies for additional support and resources
- Collaborates with The Gathering Place program staff to create and deliver educational and supportive programming to meet the needs of participants
